NGFCU prides itself in the security it provides for its members. We are seeing an increase of wire fraud and online payment scams. Please review the following alerts to ensure you are aware of these common fraud and scam practices before completing a wire request.

☐ Cryptocurrency scams: Be extremely wary of anyone offering to deal with payments in cryptocurrency. In many cases, there are no safeguards in place when cryptocurrencies are used for payment.	and beg you to wire money right away. Their goal is to trick you into sending money be realize it's a scam.
